### **Invitation to Bid – Re-Roofing Project at Sewer Treatment Plant**

The Town of Bruceton is accepting **sealed bid proposals** for the re-roofing of two buildings located at the **Bruceton Sewer Treatment Plant, Poplar Lane, Bruceton, TN 38317**. This project includes furnishing all labor, materials, and equipment necessary to install a new fully adhered 60 mil TPO roof system. 20-year or more Warranty of materials and labor.

#### **Scope of Work Includes:**

- Removal of existing gravel/tar roof and insulation down to the concrete deck
- Cleaning and priming of concrete deck for insulation
- Installation of 5" ISO insulation in adhesive
- Application of fully adhered white 60 mil TPO membrane
- Flashing of all pipes, curbs, and penetrations per manufacturer specifications
- Reflashing of existing scuppers
- Replacement of all wood nailers
- Installation of new gravel guard metal flashing
- Removal of all roofing debris from the job site
- Provision of a 20-year manufacturer's warranty to the Town upon completion
